THE AUTISM & ADHD PEER SUPPORT SERVICE

The Autism & ADHD Peer Support Service is a brand new service formed from the joining of Rotherham Parent Carer Forum's Family Peer Support, and the Rotherham Adult Neurodiversity Support Service (RANSS).

We offer tailored 1 to 1 Peer Support as well as Group Peer Support sessions, which include Focused Group Discussions and an opportunity to socialise for Autistic and ADHD adults, young people (16+) and the parents/carers of Autistic and/or ADHD people.

This service is funded by the NHS South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board, and you are eligible to access our support if you:

- Are registered with a GP within South Yorkshire ICB – Rotherham Place

AND ARE EITHER:

- An adult (16+) with a diagnosis of Autism and/or ADHD
- An adult (16+) on the pathway for assessment for Autism and/or ADHD
- The parent/carer of a person with a diagnosis of Autism and/or ADHD
- The parent/carer of a person on the pathway for assessment for Autism and/or ADHD
